	ADJECTIVE	COMPARATIVE	SUPERLATIVE
ONE syllable	fast <i>rápido</i> young <i>joven</i>	-ER faster <i>más rápido que</i> younger <i>más joven que</i>	-EST the fastest <i>el más rápido</i> the youngest <i>el más joven</i>
ONE syllable Ending in -E	nice <i>agradable</i> strange <i>extraño</i>	-R nicer <i>más agradable que</i> stranger <i>más extraño que</i>	-ST the nicest <i>el más agradable</i> the strangest <i>el más extraño</i>
ONE syllable Consonant + Short Vowel + Consonant	big <i>grande</i> hot <i>caliente</i>	Double the last consonant and add -ER bigger <i>más grande que</i> hotter <i>más caliente que</i>	-EST the biggest <i>el más grande</i> the hottest <i>el más caliente</i>
TWO syllables Ending in -Y	happy <i>feliz</i> crazy <i>loco</i>	Remove the -Y and add -IER happier <i>más feliz que</i> crazier <i>más loco que</i>	-IEST the happiest <i>el más feliz</i> the craziest <i>el más loco</i>
TWO or MORE syllables	famous <i>famoso</i> beautiful <i>guapa</i>	MORE + <i>más famoso que</i> more famous <i>más guapa que</i> more beautiful	THE MOST + <i>el más famoso</i> the most famous <i>la más guapa</i> the most beautiful
Common Exceptions	good <i>bueno</i> bad <i>malo</i>	better <i>mejor que</i> worse <i>peor que</i>	the best <i>el mejor</i> the worst <i>el peor</i>


